WHAT IS EYE

Every two years, the European Youth Event (EYE) brings together thousands of young people from all over the European Union and beyond to shape and share their ideas on the future of Europe.

It is a unique opportunity for young people to meet and inspire each other and decision makers right in the heart of European democracy.

During two days, participants have the opportunity to take part in a variety of activities and experience artistic performances, co-created with partners, youth organisations and participants themselves.


Expect also to meet many inspiring speakers, decision-makers, experts, activists and influencers!



REPORT AND HEARINGS

Following the event, the concerns, hopes and ideas from young people are presented in a report distributed to all Members of the European Parliament (MEPs).

Some participants will also be able to further develop the most inspiring ideas and present these directly to the Members of the European Parliament in the parliamentary committees during youth hearings.



PARTICIPATION

The EYE strives to promote equality with a strong commitment to accessibility for everyone.

All young Europeans who are between 16 and 30 years old can take part. To register, you need to form a group of minimum 10 people.

Participation in the EYE is free of charge. Participants need to arrange their own travel to and accommodation in Strasbourg.

The EYE is an event for youth, co-created with youth. Participants can propose and organise interactive or artistic activities.

The European Parliament is committed to promote inclusiveness and civic engagement. Groups can apply under certain conditions for a financial contribution.

Some examples of ideas from previous editions

EYE2014: Discover EU

Free train passes for young people to travel and discover Europe.

EYE2016: Broaden Erasmus

Increase in budget, more opportunities for disadvantaged youth and more co-funding and cooperation with other European programmes.

EYE2018: Single use plastic

Ban on single-use plastic cutlery, cotton buds, straws and stirrers by 2021.
